CONDITIONS OF THE SCHOOL 21 PROGRAMME

- 1. The selection of candidates for School 21 programming school takes place in several stages. Candidates who submit applications will be considered. Each stage involves a set of instruments and approaches determined by School 21 Autonomous Nonprofit Educational Organisation (hereafter referred to as the 'Project Organisers') at its discretion.
- 2. The decision on whether a candidate is admitted to the next stage of the selection process is made by the Project Organisers at their discretion.
- 3. Candidates who complete the selection stages are enrolled in the Programming School.
- 4. It is possible to study at the School for up to 4 years. Every student determines the speed at which they complete the programme.
- 5. At the end of the programme, graduates receive two certificates: one which states that they have graduated from School 21, and second which states that they have completed 42's programme (the French school).
- 6. The Project Organisers shall protect all information they receive about participants within the framework of the project against unauthorised use, distribution and publication. With the exception of cases stipulated by Russian law, this information shall not be transferred to third parties (except employees and members of management bodies of the Project Organisers) without the written consent of participants or used for purposes other than holding the project's participant selection process.
- 7. The Project Organisers shall not compensate any personal expenses incurred by the project's participants prior to, during or after the project.
- 8. School 21 operates 24/7 and its students can study round-the-clock.
- 9. Anyone aged 18 to 30 can submit an application to participate in the selection stages for participation in School 21.
